Mount Everest was first successfully climbed in 1953, but twenty years earlier two aircraft succeeded in flying over the summit.

Meryon, himself a high altitude mountaineer, will describe the 1933 expedition to be the first to fly over Everest, from its inception, the development of a powerful new aero engine, the equipment to survive the extreme conditions at 35,000 ft, and on to it's triumphal conclusion.
