Ron flew close air support missions in the UK protectorate of Aden in the 1960's, as a 43 Squadron Hunter pilot.

Following a flying instructional tour, he attended the US Navy's Test Pilot School NAS Patuxent River, Maryland, graduating in 1970.

During a test flying career, flying a wide range of US fast-jet aircraft from Skyhawk and Crusader and in the UK, Harrier and Tornado ADV, he survived two ejections and two crash landings.

He was the RAF's first Tornado pilot in 1975 and A&AEE's chief test pilot in 1985/88.
