After moving to Reading in 1982, Emeritus Professor Andy Kempe started researching the long and fascinating history of the Common.

The air base was originally built for the RAF in 1942, the USAAF soon moved in, and during the 1980's and until its closure in 1992 it became the controversial base for cruise missiles.

Andy is a volunteer at the Greenham Common Tower Heritage Centre and has also written a play about the Common and the lives of the people who lived there.
